

Think twice before applying fertilizer or weed and feed products to your lawn.

Spring nitrogen application on cool season grasses (like fescue or Kentucky bluegrass) **can be detrimental**. It promotes weed growth and increases the risk for insect damage. Improperly timed fertilizer application also increases the risk for nutrient pollution in stormwater.

Set your mower on the right height

remove less than a third of the leaf blade
